RULES AND REGULATIONS

PURPOSE

The Sunset Hill Cemetery is sacredly devoted to the burial of the dead. These grounds are in truth akin both in spirit and reverence to the churches and cathedrals of our land and to the religions of the world. Quietness, decorum and proper conduct in all respects will naturally govern all thoughtful and considerate visitors, for such is the reverence and honor due all such sanctified retreats.

The creation of a haven of hope and peace, a place of consolation and inspiration for the living, as well as a worthy dedication to those who have gone before, is the ever guiding concept in these sanctified memorial gardens. Your cooperation in observance of the following rules and regulations is vital to the full attainment of these ideas.

VISITING HOURS

We welcome your visits within the cemetery from 8:00 am to dusk daily.

TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

Speed limit in all areas of the cemetery is 15 mph.

Automobiles are permitted on designated roadways only. PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS.

No recreational riding of bicycles or motorcycles will be permitted.

FLOWERS

Floral bouquets are welcome at all times placed in invertible bronze vases. *PLEASE REMOVE WHEN THESE BEGIN TO FADE OR WITHER*.

Grave decorations, floral or otherwise, are not permitted on the graves during the growing season (approximately March 1 through October 15) except on the following holidays: Easter, Memorial Day, Mother's Day, and Father's Day.

* This does not apply to flowers displayed in invertible vases.

All grave decorations should be removed as soon as they become unsightly (usually within 7-10 days).

* Christmas decorations by February 1st.

Cemetery personnel reserve the right to remove any such decorations when not removed by the family. Glass ornaments are prohibited.

MAINTENANCE

The cemetery personnel have sole responsibility for the care and maintenance of the cemetery grounds.

Individual planting or digging within the cemetery is strictly prohibited. NO CURBING OR FENCES ALLOWED.

Any requests for assistance or special services should be directed to the Town office.

The cemetery can not accept responsibility for theft or damage to any item placed on burial spaces.

GENERAL RESTRICTIONS

Picking of flowers or breaking of shrubbery is prohibited.

No hunting or fishing.

No picnicking.

No alcoholic beverages.

No pets.

No excessive noise.

THE PRECEDING STATEMENTS ARE IN CONFORMITY WITH NATIONAL AND STATE REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF CEMETERIES, AND HAVE BEEN ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LITTLETON.
