OFFICIAL STATEMENT ON ADMINISTRATION:

While there are a lot of tasks not done or completed, there has been tremendous progress made to correct these errors. Today, 11/7/2018, we met with a team sent from the Local Government Commission, an agency of the State Treasurer's Office, and they were very positive about the progress made. They gave great direction and are going to work with us throughout the process. Our auditor was also present and was equally positive about our standing and will be assisting us throughout the process as well.

OFFICIAL STATEMENT ON WATER/SEWER RATES:

I met with Randy Welch of SERCAP last Thursday, 11/1/2018, to do a water usage audit. His findings were that there are high percentages of water loss for 7 out of 9 months audited. This information can assist us moving forward to help find where there is lost revenues that could be accounted for, thus providing a new opportunity to revisit the rate structure. However, as it stands today, the rates must meet the requirements of the state and remain as set until further evaluations can be done.

I would like to address the board if
I may? When were Letters mailed out to the
residents of Littleton notifying them of
the water increase? Not one person that
I have spoken to (at least forty people) myself
included have not received notification in
writing. I would like to pose the question
why the increase at all?

Please be advised those same residents
spoken to agree that they did however receive
notification by mail that our water, the
water that we drink is contaminated
by feces & radioactive materials. These
can cause intestinal illnesses such as
giardia or worse many forms of cancer.

I would like to relay to you before
this extreme water increase I really
"believed" in this town no pun intended.

I feel betrayed by a board that calls secret meetings. A board and town that get grant like any other town. What are being done with them? Don't we as residents have the right to ask what the intake and expenditures are? I have Read and read Littleton's mission and vision statement. Maybe there was a time that it actually held truth, not anymore.

That saddens me. Do you even realize what you are doing to the already, impoverished of this community? You are taking food and nourishment from single family homes, leaving little children's stomachs hungry. You are taking away the elderly, the disabled, and others as well with your out of control nonemergency usage amounts reflected on our bills, and the astronomical prices reflected on our bills.

Have you given thought to what people who are very ill like myself and so many others will do when we have to choose between life saving medication or water? Let me say that again. Medication that is prolonging my life or having water.

Open the eyes of your hearts.
